The Moabite Stone is a piece of rock found about 20 miles east of the Dead Sea, in modern day Jordan. It is about 4 feet tall and 2 feet wide. It has an extensive inscription in the Moabite language, which is very closely related to ancient Hebrew. The stone has thirty two lines of text written in the voice of "Mesha king of Moab." Scholars estimate that it was engraved about the 830 BC. This stone is interesting to students of the Bible for several reasons. It gives evidence for the existence of people who called themselves Moabites.

Previously, this fact was only known from the Bible. You can read about Mesha king of Moab in 2 Kings 3. The stone also mentions the name of the God of Israel, Yahweh and of Moab, Chemosh. Finally, it provides partial confirmation of King David as real historical figure. Line 31 mentions the "house of David."

We don't need archaeology to verify what the Bible says. God's Word stands on its own authority. But we do find it interesting to see the Bible proven right again and again.


Pastor's Report: Pastor reported on some membership changes for the quarter. A motion was made, seconded, and carried to transfer in from Beautiful Savior in Clarksville, Tennessee, Joel Holz.
